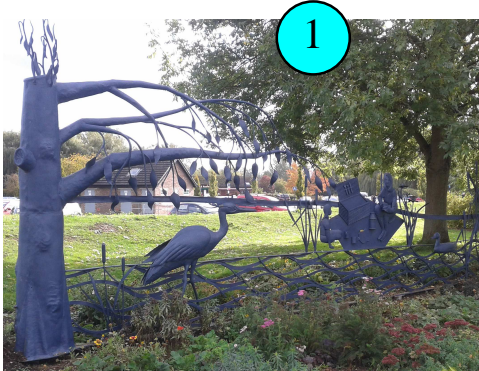


# St Neots Amazing Metal Sculptures

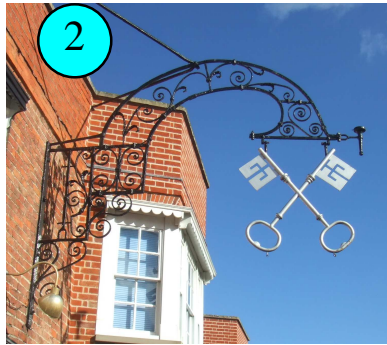
Wander around St Neots and admire some of our unique ironwork

The unique Days Column in the market square



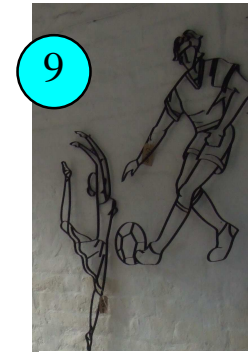
Find the protective unique railings at the cross roads



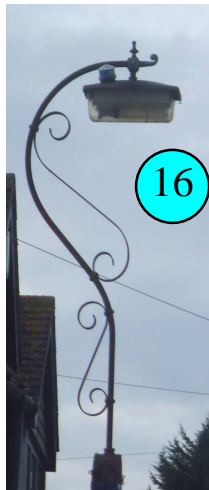
Discover this above the Jaz Yorkes pub sign



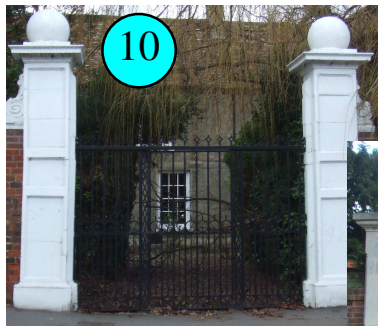
An artistic arrow holding up the jewellers sign
